



RTMC's National Feminine Care CSR Project.

The Corporation launched the National Feminine Care CSR Project at Jordan Secondary School in Emfuleni, Evaton Informal Settlements, where the Corporation distributed sanitary towels to the female learners from poverty-stricken and disadvantaged households as part of the National Feminine Care Project.

The initiative aims to assist in keeping the girl child in school, especially during the exams period as research conducted by the UNICEF confirms that female learners who do not afford sanitary towels will miss approximately five (5) school days due to not being able to afford sanitary care products.
